

You Are God's One-of-a-Kind Valentine **Valentine's Day Family Activity**

What You'll Need

- Scissors
- Tape
- Bible (*Bookmark Psalm 139:14 and Isaiah 64:8.*)
- Cube pattern (*Assemble the cube [pattern below] ahead of time. Cut along the solid lines shown. Then fold on the dotted lines to form a box or cube. Place one piece of tape on the final flap to hold the cube together. [You'll need scissors near the end of the activity.]*)

What You'll Do

After your meal has ended and the table is cleared, use the cube like a die. Gently roll the cube across the table. Beginning with the youngest person at the table, let everyone name his or her "favorite" for the topic displayed on the cube. Continue in the same manner, rolling the cube and validating each person's response.

What You'll Say

Some of our favorites are the same, but some are different. Why is that? God made us unique. His creativity is displayed in us. He loves us! (*Read Psalm 139:14 and Isaiah 64:8.*)

Sometimes our differences cause disagreements. When we argue about the best TV program or what game to play, we sin. God loves our uniqueness, but he does not like sin! That's why . . .

(Slit the tape holding the cube together and place the resulting cross—printed side down—on the table.)

God sent Jesus to be our Savior! Jesus died for our sins. Then Jesus came alive again. He lives in each of our hearts right now. Jesus can help us appreciate each other's differences. He will help our family live together in love. 1 John 4:19 says, "We love him, because he first loved us." Because Jesus loves us, we love each other, too. (*Pray together. Ask God to help your family live together in love.*)
